- Career and counseling cell has been started.

## 3. Innovation in curriculum design and transaction

The curricula for U.G. and P.G. courses have been developed as per U.G.C. standard. It contains materials related to thrust area for national development and need of the society as well as academic excellence of students for creating the scope of abilities and employability.

## 4. Inter disciplinary programs started

The college is running Environmental Studies, Computer Awareness, and Legal Awareness, as Interdisciplinary courses at under graduate level.

A new interdisciplinary program "Rastra Gaurav" has been introduced in this year.

The computer related topics are taught to students belonging to different discipline, (Arts/Science/Commerce)

## 5. Examination reforms implemented

- a. Semester system of examination is followed at U.G. Level in B.Sc., B.Com and in all post graduate level subjects.
- b. Random cross checking of the evaluated answers books is done by the controller and deputy controller of examination to ensure the reliability of the marks given by examiners.
- c. Moderation of question paper is done one hour before the commencement of examination by the subject teacher. Moderation is carried out only to check the out of course contents, paper pattern proposed by Board of Studies and printing mistakes.

- d. 10% papers are set by internal and 90% papers are set by external examiner.
- e. There is a provision for back/improvement examination to upgrade the result.
- f. Coding of roll number on examination answer books is done to maintain the secrecy and validity of the examination system.
- g. All the copies of the examinations are evaluated at the evaluation center of the college located at Parmanandpur campus.
- h. Cases of malpractices (by external or internal examination) are noticed and are dealt by examination committee.
- i. The results are declared within one month of the examination, on the college web site, notice board and in news papers.
- j. Students using unfair means are not eligible for back/Improvement examinations.
- k. Photo bearing mark sheets are issued.

- College follows academic calendar of events giving last date of receipt of application, publication of I, II and III list and last date fixed for admission based on availability of seats.
- For U.G. courses (B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com.) the admission is based on the merit of the entrance. For P.G. courses (M.A. / M.Sc.) admission is taken on the basis of merit based on marks obtained at the graduation level. Reservation is given as per government rule, weightage is given to NCC, NSS, Ranger, Sports and Co-curricular activities.

**Examination Results.**

The examination center is fully computerized. Examination cell is providing colored computerized photograph bearing mark sheet to their students. The results are declared on the college web site, notice board and news papers, within one month of the examinations.

Mark sheets are issued from examination office and other offices of the college.
